

Welcome to the Public Meeting for the Proposed Improvements to Mustang Road SH-66 (Main Street) to Wagner Road, Yukon, Oklahoma

The City of Yukon in cooperation with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) has scheduled this public meeting in an effort to involve concerned citizens in the development of plans for the proposed improvements to Mustang Road from SH-66 (Main Street) to Wagner Road. The meeting is intended to provide information on the project scope and status and solicit public input.

PROJECT SUMMARY

NEED FOR PROJECT

- Mustang Road is currently a two-lane roadway with some sections of four-lane in this segment. This configuration is inadequate for current and future traffic requirements. The City of Yukon and ODOT propose to upgrade the area to a continuous four-lane facility.

PROPOSED PROJECT SCOPE

- Reconstruct the existing lanes through this segment of roadway to develop a continuous four-lane facility.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW AND ANALYSES

- Proposal consistent with local, State, and federal planning for the area.
- No impact to travel patterns
- No displacement will occur
- No significant air quality, water quality, or noise impacts
- No significant impact to wetlands
- No effect on any federally listed endangered, threatened or candidate species
- No significant impact to cultural resources
- No hazardous waste sites or leaking underground storage tanks are known to exist or were identified

DATES

- Construction let date; late summer 2012.
- Environmental clearance; spring 2011.
- Right-of-way acquisition will begin summer 2011.
