

# **Welcome to the Public Meeting for the Proposed Improvements to S.E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Lynn Fry Boulevard to Anderson Road**

The City of Midwest City in cooperation with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) has scheduled this public meeting in an effort to involve concerned citizens in the development of plans for the proposed improvements to S.E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Lynn Fry Boulevard to Anderson Road. The meeting is intended to provide information on the project scope and status and solicit public input.

## **PROJECT SUMMARY**

### **NEED FOR PROJECT**

- S.E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street is currently a two-lane road in this segment. Two lanes are inadequate for current and future traffic requirements. The City of Midwest City and ODOT propose to reconstruct this segment of roadway to a four-lane facility.

### **PROPOSED PROJECT SCOPE**

- Reconstruct the two lanes to a four-lane divided curb and gutter street.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW AND ANALYSES**

- Proposal consistent with local, state and federal planning for the area
- No impact to travel patterns
- No displacement will occur
- No significant air quality, water quality or noise impacts
- No significant impact to wetlands
- No effect on any federally listed endangered, threatened or candidate species
- No significant impact to cultural resources
- No hazardous waste sites or leaking underground storage tanks are known to exist or were identified

### **DATES**

- Environmental clearance; fall 2010.
- Right-of-way acquisition will begin winter 2010 and end spring 2011.
- Utility relocations; spring 2011 through winter 2011.
- Construction begins; spring 2012.
